John Ayuk was born in London and did his undergraduate medical training in Berlin, graduating in 1994. He returned to the UK and after initial training in General Medicine embarked on a career in Endocrinology. During his training he completed a research fellowship in Endocrinology at the University of Birmingham. His research interests include the pathogenesis, management and outcome of pituitary tumours. He is the author of a number of papers which have influenced changes in the way acromegaly is managed. As a result of his contribution in this field, he is regularly invited to participate in consensus conferences on the management of acromegaly. He currently holds the posts of Consultant Endocrinologist at the University Hospital of Birmingham and Honorary Senior Lecturer at the University of Birmingham.
