

John Funder has worked on aldosterone and mineralocorticoid receptors for over 40 years, and with his students and fellows has contributed over 500 papers to the literature, predominantly on cardiovascular endocrinology. Over the past decade he has been instrumental in analyzing the results of clinical studies to provide new insights in to both the pathophysiology of aldosterone and the wider biology of mineralocorticoid receptors. He is a former Chairman of the Executive Committee of the I.S.E., a former President of the Endocrine Society of Australia and of the Australian Society for Medical Research, and was the first non-North American to be elected to the Council of the Endocrine Society (USA).
